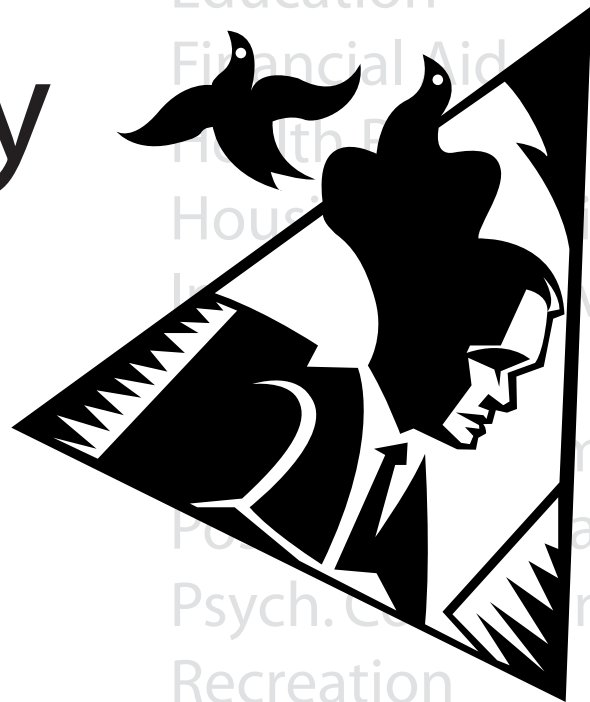

## 10. Education & English as a Second Language

These educational resources are especially significant for people with TBI for a variety of reasons. People with TBI are predominantly young and thus may not have completed their education. They often require ‘cognitive retraining’ to help them with the unique problem areas that are typical of TBI, such as impaired attention, concentration, and difficulty retaining new learning. They may need training or more education to move into another line of work, as they are not able to do the work they did before. English as a Second Language (ESL) is important to help those with TBI who don’t speak English to avoid the ‘double handicap’ of having a TBI and also not being able to speak the language of the predominant culture.

The Community Colleges have taken the lead in providing educational resources for people with cognitive deficits, including TBI, through their Disabled Students’ Programs. They can often provide assessments, tutors, and materials to help the students get the most out of their education.

English as a Second Language (ESL) is provided in several different types of settings: schools, cultural centers, and community organizations. It is best to find an ESL class that specializes in working with people from that culture. For example, Asian Americans for Community Involvement (AACI) have ESL classes for their Asian population; referring someone from Central America to them would not be as effective as referring that person to a class that knows the Hispanic culture. Local classes can be found in many adult schools, as listed below for the San Jose area (San Jose Adult Center).
